WHAT IS PULL FOR THE HOUSE?

This is a pull tab recycling program that benefits the Ronald McDonald House of Mid-Michigan.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Just save the tab off your beverage cans, tennis ball can lids, Pringles cans, pet food cans, or any other can with an aluminum pull tab. (Aluminum will not stick to a magnet.) There is a value to this alloy. The Ronald McDonald House collects the tabs and turns them into cash to assist the House and underwrite the cost of lodging for the families that stay with us. The pull tab recycling program is our premiere awareness program and something everyone can do. This program raises nearly \$5,000 annually for the House.

WHAT DOES THE RONALD McDONALD HOUSE DO?

A Ronald McDonald house is a home-away-home for ill children receiving treatment at area hospitals and clinics and their families. The first House was opened in Philadelphia, PA. There are over 300 Houses worldwide in 36 countries providing over 30,000 sleeping rooms every night for families in crisis.

WHAT DO WE DO WITH THE PULL TABS ONCE THEY ARE COLLECTED?

Collect your tabs in shoe boxes, baggies, old peanut cans, or any wide-mouthed container that allows for easy dumping of the tabs. Please count your tabs and bring a sheet notating how many tabs you are collecting. Bring the tabs with you to the Michigan Children's Cluster on March 11, 2017, Lansing Community College West Campus.

WHAT DO WE GET FOR PARTICIPATION?

The Ronald McDonald House of Mid-Michigan recognizes all donors. Jack and Jill of America Incorporated will be listed in their newsletter, and if we reach one million tabs, we will become a member of The Ronald McDonald House Million Tab Club. These groups receive a certificate, and their name appears on the Million Tab Club plaque located by the collection container in the vestibule at the House. --You also receive the satisfaction of giving a helping hand to the House and families, who are experiencing the very worst thing that could happen -- the illness of a child.
